


ACROPOLIS RESIDENCE ARCHITECTURAL STUDY DESIGN AND SUPERVISION BY ANAKTAE

This comprehensive architectural study concerns the addition of one floor on a single-storey house in the Acropolis area.

The owners requested a radical renovation of the entire structure, in order to transform the property into a functional family home without losing any of its neoclassical charm.

During the process, it was revealed that the house had suffered severe damages throughout the years so Two Is Company finally decided to demolish a large portion of the property, solely maintaining the external shell and its robust stone structure.

ANAKTAE redesigned the entire layout from the beginning, which now revolved around an oak staircase, a design element dictated by the property's neoclassical character.


The principal construction materials were warm wood, sleek marble and concrete tiles with traditional hand-painted patterns that all came together in a clean, illuminated interior landscape with a beautiful view.

The house had suffered severe damages throughout the years so the firm finally decided to demolish a large portion of the property, solely maintaining the external shell and its robust stone structure.



All decorative elements were faithfully reproduced according to the original after thorough analysis.





Sleek marble was chosen to give a luxurious style in the new bathroom.



The patio was handled with care so as to create a great view from the interior and a pleasant and comfortable outdoor space to spend time in.



A rooftop garden was installed so as to reduce temperatures of the roof surface.



The corbels of the façade were designed from scratch based on neoclassical principals and hand carved on massif slabs of sleek Dionysos marble.




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THE FACADE

A new storey was added and the decorative pulled plaster detailing on the façade, was faithfully reproduced according to the original.



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
